## SRI2024

The next <u>Sustainability Research and Innovation (SRI) Congress</u> will be held for the first time in Europe, taking place in Helsinki and Espoo, **Finland**, and online on **10 - 14 June, 2024**. The SRI Congress is the world's largest inclusive global event for co-produced research and innovation action to advance sustainability. The 2024 Congress builds on a growing knowledge to action movement fostered in previous SRI Congresses held in Australia, South Africa and Panama. More than 2000 international sustainability experts and practitioners are expected to come together in Finland and online from around the world. The DKN will be part of the open-access session *How Can We Design* 

Effective Science-Policy Interface? Learning from the Best Practices and Experiences from Future Earth's National Committees.

## Future Earth Pathways Autumn School 2024

The 3rd edition of the Future Earth Pathways Autumn School will take place on **25 - 29 November 2024** in Aussois in the **French Alps**. It will gather 50 young researchers and senior researchers to share and reflect around the theme "Transformative Research for a Just World and a Habitable Planet". The **call for applications closes on 22 May 2024**. This year, the DKN is once again involved as a partner in the Pathways Autumn School, which is organized by the French Future Earth Hub. The school aims to foster exchange of knowledge and learning through critical dialogue between early career scientists and senior researchers from the natural sciences, social sciences, and the humanities.

## **Future Earth Pathways Forum**

The Future Earth Pathways Forum is an open webinar series aimed at developing critical reflections on sustainability science. The Pathways Initiative convenes an international and diverse community of researchers for discussions and mutual learning on a variety of sustainability science concepts, methods, and concrete cases. ## **10 Must-Knows from Biodiversity Research 2024**

In the *10 Must-Knows from Biodiversity Research 2024*, 64 scientists have further developed their well-founded and diverse findings and recommendations from the 10MustKnows22. With the 10MustKnows24, they want to make an active contribution to accelerating the socio-ecological transformation in the crucial six years up to 2030 through scientifically sound recommendations for politics and society. ## German Advisory Council on Global Change - WBGU

In April 2024, the WBGU presented the policy paper "<u>Biodiversity: Act</u> <u>Now for Nature and Humanity</u>" to Federal Environment Minister Steffi Lemke and Ms. von Messling, Head of Department at the Federal Ministry of Education and Research. The key messages of the paper deal with the successful protection of climate and biodiversity as a prerequisite for healthy living.

#### **German Advisory Council on the Environment - SRU**

- The SRU has recently <u>updated its work on a national CO2 budget for</u> <u>Germany</u>. It shows that rapid emission reductions are crucial. The current paper updates the SRU's CO2 budget calculations on the basis of the latest scientific knowledge. It also answers a number of questions that came up in public discussion.
- The SRU presented a paper on the topic of <u>Suifficiency as a</u> <u>strategy of enough</u> with 16 theses that are intended to invite politicians, civil society, science and business to discuss the issue.

 Jointly with two federal advisory councils (<u>WBBGR</u> and <u>WBW</u>), the SRU has developed <u>recommendations for a renaturation policy</u> for the federal and state governments. The report "<u>Renaturation:</u> <u>Strengthening biodiversity, managing land sustainably</u>" (in German only) was submitted to the Federal Environment Ministry in April. The core recommendations of the report will be presented and discussed in an <u>online event</u> on **23 May 2024**.

#### German Sustainable Development Strategy

The federal cabinet adopted the "Energy transition and climate action challenges and paths of transformation" report (in German only). The report is a building block in the development of the German Sustainable Development Strategy, and focuses in particular on the international dimension of climate action.

## Intergovernmental Panel for Climate Change - IPCC

The IPCC is calling on its member governments and observer organizations to nominate experts who will draft the outline of the Working Group contributions to the Seventh Assessment Report. Nominations should be submitted by 7 June 2024. Nominations from Germany are handled by the German focal point and need to be communicated by **24 May 2024**.
