Sustainability Research and Innovation Congress 2022: Panel Discussion on Research Priorities for Sustainability Science As part of the <u>Sustainability Research & Innovation Congress 2022</u> (SRI2022) the DKN organized an open-access online session on 23 June 2022. Building on the DKN position paper <u>"Research Priorities for</u> <u>Sustainability Science"</u>, the panel discussion treated current challenges and important future research fields. Focal points of the discussion were the interrelations of sustainability and climate sciences using the example of the food crisis. Besides DKN members Daniela Jacob, Michael Bollig und Markus Reichstein, panelists were Daphne Frank (GIZ, Germany), Ibrahima Hathie (Initiative Prospective Agricole et Rurale, Senegal), Corine Pelluchon (Université Gustave Eiffel, France) and Chris du Preez (University of the Free State, South Africa). Pathways Postdoctoral Grants: Call for Expressions of Interest and Information & Networking Webinar

Future Earth's <u>Pathways Initiative</u> has launched a Call for Expressions of Interest for the <u>Pathways Postdoctoral Grants</u>. The grants will support 3 Pathways Projects aimed at encouraging and enhancing collaboration between various research communities working on pathways for sustainability and synthesizing existing knowledge about the approaches for developing pathways within a specific theme. A Pathways Project will be developed by a working group that will include a postdoctoral researcher funded through the grant. Overall, the grants will support 3 working groups on three different themes and their postdoctoral researchers over a 24-month period. The deadline for Expressions of Interest is *11 September 2022*. Sustainability Research and Innovation Congress

The 2022 Sustainability Research and Innovation Congress took place from 20-24 June 2022 at the Future Africa Institute, in Pretoria, South Africa. The event brought together over 1600 sustainability science professionals from more than 100 countries, both online and onsite, and showcased the latest advances in sustainability research and innovation and addressed critical themes shaping the future of sustainability. Recordings of all 200+ sessions are now available for all registered participants.

The next edition of the Sustainability Research and Innovation Congress will be held in <u>June 2023 in Panama</u>. The National Secretariat for Science, Technology and Innovation (Senacyt) will host the congress in collaboration with its co-host, the Inter-American Institute for Global Change Research (IAI).
